ADMISSION REQUIREMENT

India: CBSE or ICSE Grade 12 results or State Board Exams Applications can be made online or through paper forms All applicants are required to present proof of English fluency for all undergraduate programs. The following tests are accepted by the university:

- Cambridge English: Minimum score of 180
- CAEL: Minimum score of 80
- Caribbean Examinations: A final grade of A or B
- Duolingo English Test: Minimum score of 120
- ELDA: Minimum score of 86
- GCSE/iGCSE: Minimum score of B
- IB English: Minimum score of 4
- IELTS Academic: Minimum band of 6.5
- PTE Academic: Minimum score of 65TOEFL: Minimum score of 89
